HANDS-ON ROBOTIC UROLOGY COURSE

June 29-30, 2010

It is my pleasure to invite you to our second year of hands-on-training robotic course in urology. Since fall 2008, our Department of Surgery has organised training facilities which enable to provide teaching of robotic surgery on human cadavers.

Who should take this course ? Surgeons wishing to receive practical operative training in 2 of the most practised robotic operations in urology : radical prostatectomy and pyeloplasty. *To best take advantage of this course, basic knowledge and practice with the da Vinci robot is highly recommended. For those of you lacking this training, we hold a practical course of introduction to the da Vinci robot the afternoon before the course begins.* You may registrate for this introduction course on our website or per e-mail on the registration address (christine.duvanel@hcuge.ch).

As outlined in the following program, the course is focused on intense practical sessions under the supervision of national experts in robotic urologic surgery. Steps of the procedure are introduced by an audio-visual summary immediately translated on the human cadaver. There will be one cadaver available for a maximum of 4 participants per course, so that 4 surgeons can work as a rotating team: one operator, one on-site assistant, one instrument assistant and one observer. Since training places are limited, registration will be handled on a first-come first-serve basis.
