This year, during the ERUS 10 in Bordeaux, we have the chance to organize the first meeting for junior users of “da Vinci” Robot in Urology. Thanks to the board of ERUS this realise the “Junior-ERUS group” that include under 40s urologists and you can be with us.

If you are less than 40 years old and you are interested in robotic surgery you have the possibility to be part of this group to exchange our experiences, talk about how to learn robotic surgery and define together training programs for young urologist in this field.

Our propose is to begin a discussion in order to develop a project for commune European training program for Robotic Surgery that could be exported in all European Countries in order to define the formation of European resident in this field.

The best video and the best oral presentation will win one month Fellowship in a referred European Robotic Centre and one free participation to the next ERUS course. Moreover the abstract not selected for the award section, but accepted from the jury and the reviewers, will be presented during the abstract sections of ERUS. All the accepted presentations will be published on European Urology in the Abstract book.

Abstract Submission Guidelines

The abstract and video should follow the same rule for ERUS submission but to be selected for the Junior session and for Prize have to be prepared and presented by an under 40 years old urologist (1st author) and sent to the ERUS specifying Junior-ERUS session participation.

The videos and oral presentation should be maximum 7 minutes length and will have 3 minutes for the discussion. They have to be sent following the instructions on the ERUS 2010 website <http://www.erus2010.com/programme/poster-video-submissions> but be sure to specify Junior ERUS 2010 in the Title.

The Deadline for the abstracts presentation is 2010 June 15th.

Prizes

We will supply two prizes with formation purpose, addressed to residents or young urologist that will provide the best originals scientific contributes in which he/she is the first author and in which he/she played a significant role in the procedures or study.

Video prize: One month in a referred European center for robotic surgery. Round trip flight and a study bourse for accommodation. (Details will be defined)

Oral presentation prize: Inscription, round trip and accommodation for ERUS 2011.

The abstract to be presented during the Junior session will be selected by the ERUS Reviewers and Board as well the prizes will be assigned following the ERUS rules.
